


USER MANUAL Lasal Flotation Cushions

Lasal Flotation Cushions are used for positioning in the pool during training and water therapy. The Flotation Cushions are developed especially for disabled children and adults but can also be used by people in need of extra support in the water.

Lasal Flotation Cushions can be used in pools with chlorinated water.

1. Safety

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

The symbol \triangle in this user guide indicates a safety guide. Safety instructions must be followed carefully.

Lasal Flotation Cushions can withstand use in pools in chlorinated water. But must not, despite their buoyancy, be considered as life jackets or other rescue equipment.

Several of the flotation cushions cannot be fastened around the user's body and are therefore only intended to be used as support. It is the responsibility of the staff to assess the user's cognitive and physical abilities to stay afloat in the water.

Lasal Flotation Cushions must not be exposed to strong chemicals but can be hand washed with soap and water or sprayed with a disinfectant. The pH of the disinfectant used should not exceed 11.4.

Lasal Flotation Cushions can be machine washed at 60°C in a large washing machine. Especially the Banana shaped Cushions size M and L should be washed in an industrial washing machine.

Drying in a drying cabinet must not exceed 70°C, otherwise the filling will be damaged.

Avoid sharp edges, rough surfaces, and sharp objects against the cushions. Never use defect Lasal Flotation Cushions.

Lasal Flotation Cushions must not be exposed to high temperatures, prolonged and intense sunlight, cold or other radiation. It can affect the surface temperature and durability of the Flotation Cushions.

4. Use

Lasal Flotation Cushions are developed for disabled children and adults but can also be used by people in need of extra support in the water.

The flotation cushions are used for positioning in the pool during training as well as various forms of water therapy. The cushions contribute to more training options and ensure a comfortable water experience for the user.

Lasal Flotation Cushions, despite their buoyancy, must not be considered as life jackets or other rescue equipment.

Several of the flotation cushions cannot be fastened around the user's body and are therefore only intended for support in the water. It is the responsibility of the staff to assess the user's cognitive and physical abilities to stay afloat in the water. If the flotation cushions are left wet on the floor, in boxes etc., mold formation can occur. Rinse them with unchlorinated water and hang them to dry.

Recycling

Please note that Lasal Flotation Cushions must be cleaned/disinfected before used by a new user. This is done to avoid crosscontamination.

Contraindications

There are no contraindications associated with the use of Lasal Flotation Cushions.

5. About Lasal Flotation Cushions

The flotation cushions are made in several models and sizes for both children and adults. The different models can be used individually or combined according to each user's needs.

Which cushions and how many to use depends on the activity, the user's abilities and whether other props or aids are used in the water.

The flotation cushions have great buoyancy. When the cushions are filled with water, they ensure stability and support, which means a safe and comfortable experience for the user in the water.

The flotation cushions can be placed around the user before the user is immersed in the water.

The flotation cushions have a blue and a black side. It is recommended that the black side must be turned towards the user's body.

The Lasal Flotation Cushions are available in the following models

- Collar Float: 4 sizes
- Neck Floating Collar: 2 sizes
- Banana shaped Floating Cushion: 3 sizes
- U-shaped Neck Floating Cushion: 1 size
- T-shaped Floating Cushion: 2 sizes
- Flower Float: 2 sizes
- Floating Stabilizer: 2 sizes



Banana-shaped Flotation Cushions have a great floating effect. Here located below the neck and under the arms.

7. How to use Lasal Flotation Cushions



Collar Floats

Standing upright

Place the collar around the user's neck. Close the front along the length of the chest. Tighten the strap around the collar under the user's neck.

Lying on the back

Tighten the long belt around the user's body. It helps the body up in a floating position.



Stabilizer

With the stabilizer, the user actively moves around in the water in a back or abdominal supine position.

The user is placed sitting, lying, or standing between the cushions.

Can be used for balance training. Available in two sizes.



Neck Collar

Equipped with velcro so the collar can be placed close to the head / neck.

For light support during swimming training or in combination with other cushions.



Flower Floats

Equipped with velcro so the flower can be placed close to the user.

For light support during swimming training or in combination with other cushions.



T-Shaped Cushions

For floating support of the lower extremities.

For users with a certain stability in the water, the cushions can also be used as a buoyancy aid in the supine position. The cushion can be placed under the armpits with the T pointing up towards the face.



U-Cushion

Used under the neck in a supine position, under the abdomen or upper arms when breast stroking.

Also used as an extra float effect for arms or legs.



Banana shaped Cushions

Available in several sizes, all with great buoyancy. Typically placed under the armpit and body and used for back, abdominal and standing exercises.

This cushion is not designed for fastening around the body.

8. Cleaning and disinfection

Rinse the outside of the Lasal Flotation Cushion clean of chlorine after use with plenty of clean, non-chlorinated water.

Hang the flotation cushion for drying. The blue net side is turned down so the water can drip of the cushion. The drying time of the cushion is long.

The flotation cushions can be hand washed with soap and water or sprayed with a disinfectant.

Please note that the pH of the disinfectant used should not exceed 11.4.

If necessary, the flotation cushions can be machine washed at 60°C in a large washing machine. Especially the Banana shaped Cushions should be washed in an industrial washing machine. Flotation Cushions must not be tumble dried, but can dry in a drying cabinet at max. 70°C.

Temperatures above 70°C destroy the filling as the polystyrene beads melt above 71°C.

Avoid bleaches, fabric softener and other cleaning products that contain solvents.

9. Storage

Lasal Flotation Cushions must not be stored in direct sunlight or exposed to strong moisture or odor.

9.1 Long term storage

For long term storage (over three months), Lasal Flotation Cushions should be stored in the dark and not exposed to strong odors or moisture.

The Flotation Cushions should be stored in plus temperatures between 0° and 40°C.

Make sure that Lasal Flotation Cushions are completely dry before putting them away for storage.

10. Recycling and disposal

Lasal Flotation Cushion that are no longer in use are disposed of in an environment friendly manner. Contact Cobi Rehab or relevant authorities for further information on disposal.

11. Warranty

Cobi Rehab guarantees that Lasal Flotation Cushions from Cobi Rehab are flawless when delivered.

Should, contrary to expectations, there be defects or damage to the cushions upon receipt, contact Cobi Rehab immediately.

The warranty period for Lasal Flotation Cushion is one year from the date of purchase and covers production defects or defects on delivery. The invoice is valid as proof of warranty.

The guarantee does not apply to:

-products where the serial number, batch number etc. has been removed or significantly damaged.

11.1 Unintended event

Report any incidents related to the use of Lasal Flotation Cushions to Cobi Rehab

11.2 After expected service life

After the expected service life, it is important that an overall assessment of the product is made before continued use.

After the expected service life, Cobi Rehab cannot guarantee the suitability and safety of the product, as Cobi Rehab has no control over how the product is used and wear and tear. - products that have repaired by unauthorized personnel.

The guarantee does not cover:

-wear parts.

The guarantee does not apply if Cobi Rehab assesses that Lasal Flotation Cushions have not been used as intended.

In case of damage due to incorrect use, both service and used spare parts will be invoiced.

Warranties do not restrict the statutory warranty rights, the use of which is free of charge.

The overall assessment of the product must be carried out by qualified professionals, and as a minimum, consideration must be given to how the product has been used, the condition of the product and its components.

Cobi Rehab can always make such an assessment.

Filling	Fire-retardant EPS beads (expanded polystyrene)	
Cover- black side	100% polyester, not flame retardant	
Cover- blue side	100% polyester, not flame retardant	
Cleaning	After use, rinse the cushion clean for chlorine with non-chlorine-containing water.	
	Hang them up and let them drip off.	
	The cushions can be hand washed with soap and water or sprayed with a disinfectant.	
	Note that the pH of the applied disinfectant should not be higher than 11.4.
