Do not expose Lasal Positioning Cushions to high temperatures, prolonged and intense sunlight, cold or other radiation, as it can affect the surface temperature and durability of the product.

Avoid using sharp or pointed objects near cushions and covers.

4. Use

With a Lasal Positioning Cushion the user will experience a comfortably and pleasant support of the body without feeling fixed.

For the caregiver, the cushions are an easy-to-use tool facilitating more varied and correct postures. Correct postures can prevent contractures, reduce spasticity, and prevent pressure ulcers.

Lasal Positioning Cushions are also ideal for delimitation and increased body-consciousness.

The cushions are used to position adults and children in supine and sitting positions.

Patient group

Lasal Positioning Cushions are ideally used by patients within the following patient groups:

- Dementia
- Geriatric
- Neurology
- Palliation
- Chronic pain patients.

Common to these patients, is that many of them are at risk of developing tissue damage and pressure ulcers.

4.1 Contra indications

There are no contraindications associated with positioning with Lasal positioning Cushions.

Positioning Cushions and other assistive aids

Lasal Positioning Cushions can successfully be used with other assistive products from Cobi Rehab, such as Cobi Positioning Cushions, Kelvin Comfort Wheelchair and Reden MobiBed.

Re-use

Please notice, that Lasal Positioning Cushions must be thoroughly disinfected if they are to be used by another user. This is done to avoid crosscontamination. See the section on **Cleaning and maintenance**.

The various covers for Lasal Positioning Cushions must be thoroughly washed or replaced before switching to a new user.



5. Lasal Positioning Cushions

Construction

Lasal Positioning Cushions are available in multiple shapes and sizes. The combination of small beads of polystyrene in a smooth inner cushion covered with a hygiene or cotton cover contributes to each cushion adjusting to the body shape as well as the supporting surface.

Lasal Positioning Cushions are mouldable and therefore more stable than ordinary cushions.

There are two different covers to each Lasal Positioning Cushion. A cotton cover in different colors and a grey hygiene cover.

The cotton cover is breathable, washable, and anti-bacterially treated. The hygiene cover is washable and mold and fungus resistant.

Soothing effect

In addition to reducing pressure and increasing pressure distribution, the cushions are suitable for reducing spasticity, as well as providing tactile stimuli, which is recommended in cases of e.g., dementia.

Being positioned and surrounded by cushions provides a sense of being cocooned, which often has a calming effect and increases comfort.

Cobi Positioning Cushions

Cobi Rehab's positioning cushions assortment also includes more than 15 different Cobi Positioning Cushions. The two series can be combined and provide unlimited positioning options for the individual, as they together meet the need for comfort, relief, rest, and support of the whole body.

In the design of Cobi Positioning Cushions, we have focused on being able to position the cushions tightly and close to the user's body.

The cushions have a certain weight which contributes to staying in place once positioned and provide both stability and support.


The Cobi Positioning Cushions are filled with beads of expanded polystyrene, cold foam, viscoelastic foam, and SEBS granules to create density.

Unlike Lasal Cushion Cobi Positioning Cushions are also used in the positioning of bariatric users.

We highly recommend the combination of Lasal and Cobi positioning Cushions in most positioning situations.

7. Get to know the different positioning cushions

7.1 Lasal T-Cushion

The T-Cushion is used as an abduction cushion, between the legs, or for support of the lower limbs.

It is also used for prone position, where it lifts the person up into a convenient height from the supporting surface making the position more comfortable and giving the shoulders more freedom of movement.

Lasal T-Cushion is available in six sizes.

7.2 Lasal Half Moon Cushion

Half Moon Cushions are used for support of the arm and hand, in the arch, in both seated and supine position and for pressure relief between the knees and feet.

Lasal Half Moon Cushion is available in three sizes.

7.3 Lasal Triangular Cushion

The Triangular Cushion is a relatively firm cushion and is used as a stabilizer along the body in a seated or supine position or as a filling in the bed.

The smaller Triangle Cushions is used for supporting the knees or along the lower limbs.


Lasal Triangular Cushion is available in four sizes.

7.4 Lasal Neck Cushion

Neck Collar is placed around the neck in a circle. It supports and stabilizes the head and neck region in a partly sitting position. The collar is mouldable, and the filling can be pushed to where it is needed the most.

Cover can be ordered with grip tape closure, whereby the collar can be closed more closely to the neck.

Lasal Neck Cushion is available in two sizes.









7.5 Lasal Square Cushion

Lasal Square Cushions are mouldable universal cushions particularly suited to support the head, arms, legs, and feet.

Square cushions can also relieve "weak sides" while maintaining a comfortable position.

Lasal Square Cushion is available in six sizes (one is not depicted).

7.6 Lasal U-Shaped Neck Cushion

Lasal U-shaped Neck Cushion is loosely placed on the shoulder and supports neck and head in lying and supported sitting position.

Lasal U-shaped Neck Cushion can also be used to stabilize a hemiplegic arm when sitting or lying on the side.

Lasal U-shaped Neck Cushion is available in three sizes.

7.7 Lasal Support Cushion

Support Cushions are slightly chubby and oblong shaped, and wedge shaped in height.

Lasal Sit Cushions are used as seat cushions. The special wedge shape stabilizes the seat position.

Lasal Sit Cushion is available in three sizes.

7.8 Lasal Banana Cushions


Banana Cushion is moderately filled, which makes it mouldable. The filling is distributed to fit into the desired position.

Banana Cushions can be used by children and adults for positioning during e.g., training, or therapeutic exercise.

The cushions are also suitable to encircle the user helping to create calmness and security.

Lasal Banana Cushion is available in three sizes.









7.9 Embracer Cushion

In seated and lying position the Embracer makes it possible for the user to relax both arms from the neck to the fingertips without the arms falling to the side.

It is equipped with a belt, which makes it possible to fasten the Embracer to the back of a chair or wheelchair to prevent the cushion from sliding down every time the person moves.

Lasal Embracer is available in three sizes. Please note that Lasal Embracer is not depicted on the Cushion Overview.

Embracer S, Size 76x66x92, Blue, Item number: 0305-6441-000.

Embracer M, Size 87x70x113, Green, Item number: 0305-6421-000.

Embracer L, Size 95x78x117, Navy, Item number: 0305-6401-000.

7.10 Lasal Sit Sack

The Sit Sack is developed for users with a special need of support and stabilization in everyday life.

The Sit Sack embraces as well as stabilizes the user when seated or lying in it.

Lasal Sit Sack is available in three sizes. Please note that Lasal Sit Sack is not depicted on the Cushion Overview.

Sit Sack, child, Red, Weight 6.6 kg, Item number: 0317-3201-000 (depicted).

Sit Sack, junior, Green, Weight 10.5 kg, Item number: 0317-4201-000.

Sit Sack, adult, Blue, Weight 18 kg, Item number: 0317-5201-000.







8. How to position with Lasal Positioning Cushion



Daily cleaning of Lasal Positioning Cushions

Wipe the cushions with a clean cloth wrung out in water with a mild detergent. The cushions must be completely dry before they are used again or put away.

Desinfection and wash

For surface disinfection of the cushions use disposable cloths with ethanol (e.g., Wet Wipe 70 %) or a chlorine product 1000-1200 ppm (e.g., Wet Wipe Chlorine Desinfection).

The cotton cover is machine washable at 60° C and the hygiene cover at 95° C. Both covers can be tumble dried at low temperatures.

The cotton cover shrinks approx. 5% and the color will fade over time.

When machine washing the different types of covers, the zipper must be zipped, otherwise it may be damaged.

▲ Lasal Positioning Cushions without cover do not withstand machine washing but can be cleaned with a mild detergent or disinfected.

10. Storage

Do not expose the cushions to high temperatures, prolonged and intense sunlight, or other radiation.

10.1 Long-time storage

For long-term storage (over three months) Lasal Positioning Cushions must be stored in the dark and not exposed to strong odors or moisture.

The Positioning Cushions must be stored in plus temperatures, from 0°- 40° C.

11. Recycling and disposal

Dispose of products that are no longer in use in an environmentally safe manner. Contact your local authority for further information on disposal. Cobi Rehab warrants that the Lasal Positioning Cushions are without defects on delivery. If, against all expectations, the cushions are subject to deficiencies or defects on receipt, please contact Cobi Rehab immediately.

The warranty period for the Lasal Positioning Cushions is one year from the date of purchase and covers manufacturing defects or defect on receipt. The invoice is your certificate of warranty.

The warranty does not apply to:

- products on which the serial number, batch number or the like have been removed or significantly damaged.

- products which have been repaired by unauthorised personnel.

12.1 Unintended incidents

Report any incidents related to the use of Lasal Positioning Cushions to Cobi Rehab.

The warranty does not cover: - wearing parts.

This warranty does not apply when Cobi Rehab assesses that the Lasal Positioning Cushions have been improperly used.

For damage caused by improper use, an invoice will be issued for both the service and the spare parts used.

12.2 After expected product service life

After the expected product service life, it is important to make an overall assessment of the product before continuing to use it.

After the expected product service life Cobi Rehab cannot guarantee the safety and the suitability of the product as Cobi Rehab has no control over how the product has been used and the wear and tear of the product. The overall assessment of the product should be carried out by qualified professionals, and as a minimum, should consider how the product has been used, the condition of the product and its component parts.

Hygiene cover	PU-covered flame retardant polyester textile. Mold and fungus resistant.
Cleaning of inner cushion	The inner cover does not withstand machine washing but can be cleaned with a mild detergent or disinfected.
Washing of covers	The cotton cover is machine washable at 60° C and the hygiene cover at 95° C. Both covers can be tumble dried at low temperatures. The cotton cover shrinks approx. 5% and the color will fade over time.
